9-POINT TIEBREAKER

This is the tiebreaker played at 10 games all (10-10) in our TNT proset.

This is a "FIRST-TEAM-TO-5 POINTS" tiebreaker. You do not have to win by two points.

- First server is the natural order of whose serve it is next.
 This person serves two serves, from normal positions of serve to deuce court and then serve to ad court.
 This is Team #1 first server.
- Second server is the one who has been serving on the opposite side of the first server. (This means you do not change sides for serve at this point.)
 This person serves two serves, from normal positions of serve to deuce court and then serve to ad court. Team #2 is serving.
- Teams change sides.
 Next server is Team #1's second player.
 This person serves two serves, from normal positions of serve to deuce court and then serve to ad court.

IF neither team has reached 5 points, you continue on.

4. Next serve is Team #2's second player.

This person serves two serves, from normal positions of serve to deuce court and then serve to ad court.

If the score gets to 4 all (4-4), then this last server serves one more time. The receiving team gets to decide who receives the serve.

Whoever wins this last point wins the tiebreaker. They get 1 game point for this win. The match score would be 11-10.
